## How does it work?

Beginning Monday, December 5<sup>th</sup>, students in the 7<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup> grades can bring in grade-appropriate, gently used books to the Library. The collection of books will run through Friday, December 16<sup>th</sup>. On Monday, December 19<sup>th</sup>, students who donated books can come back to the Library to select books of interest to take with them.

We will be working on the honor system – students who participate should do a one-for-one exchange and take only the number of books that they have donated! We request that students limit themselves to five books.

**December 5-16, 2011: Two-week time frame to donate books**  
**December 19-23, 2011: Students may take “Book Swap” books from the Library**

The more books that get donated, the better the selection for students! We hope that the Book Swap will allow students to clear out books that they are done with and replace them with fresh and exciting reading for the winter vacation. Happy reading!
