# Overview

## Mission

---

*Acting in accordance to the values and principles of Hunter Elementary, our Hawk’s Nest After-School Program continues to facilitate the growth and development of our intellectually gifted students in an environment that fosters academic, creative, physical, and social progress through hands-on activities and peer interaction. Utilizing the experience and talents of Hunter teachers and other qualified specialists, the program is designed to accommodate and enhance the intellectual needs of Hunter children, while offering them a safe learning environment after regular school hours.*

## Program Schedule

---

The Hawk’s Nest After-School Program is available throughout the school year to Hunter students from September-June. The program is further divided into two 17 week sessions. The fall session begins on September 15<sup>th</sup> and lasts until January 23<sup>rd</sup>. The spring session begins on February 2<sup>nd</sup> and lasts until June 12<sup>th</sup>.

A general day at Hawk’s Nest begins at 2:50pm, when students convene for a snack and social period. Each child must bring their own snack as one will not be provided by Hunter. Subsequent to snack time, students will engage in their selected course activity from 3:10-4:30pm. When students are released from their selected courses, the second half of Hawk’s Nest will begin and offers additional programming options.

The Hawk’s Nest program *ends promptly at 5:45pm*, when children will be released from their respective courses for final pick-up.

## Fees

---

One day at Hawk’s Nest is equivalent to \$24 dollars per child per day. Payments are for the entire session and refunds will not be issued for those days that your child is absent. This price includes one first period enrichment course and one second period enrichment course (2:50pm-5:45pm) for one, 17 week session. Your child can enroll for up to five days per week and may be picked up at any time throughout after-school hours. In addition, no refunds will be made subsequent to the second week of courses. Scholarships are available and based upon financial need. Associated late fees for pick-up after 5:45pm is \$10 per every 15 minute increment.

It is our goal for all students to have the opportunity to enroll in at least one course. **To apply for a scholarship, please fill out the form on page 7 and submit to Principal Collins for review.**

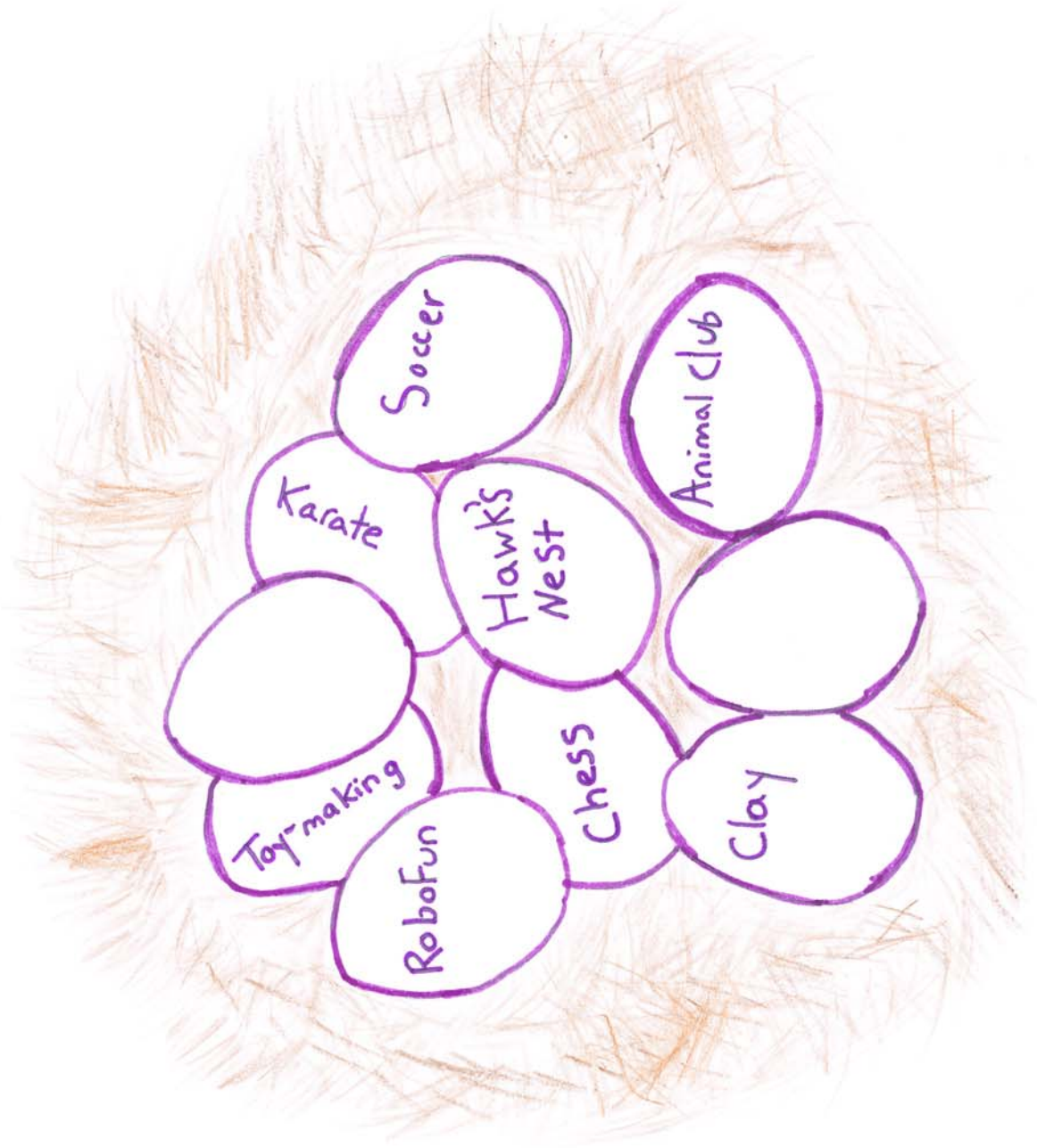
**Please note that payments for Hawk’s Nest can be divided into two equal payments. The first installment is due upon registration and the second installment is due no later than Friday,**

**November 21st.** It is necessary for these payments to be submitted in order for your child to reserve and maintain his or her enrollment in the Hawk's Nest program. Checks should be made payable to *HCES: Hawk's Nest* with your child's name and grade written clearly on the memo line. Payments can be delivered or mailed to the main office at Hunter (71 E. 94<sup>th</sup> St NY, NY 10128). Check or money order only please. Any outstanding balances from previous sessions must be paid in order to register.

### Registration

---

Registration for the fall session of the Hawk's Nest program commences in late summer and is open until early September. Spring session registration begins in December and will continue until late January. We are very excited to announce that we have a brand new online registration system that will make the registration process much easier and will maintain better student data. **The new system is slated to 'go live' on August 1<sup>st</sup>.** An email will be sent in July to confirm the opening of fall registration.

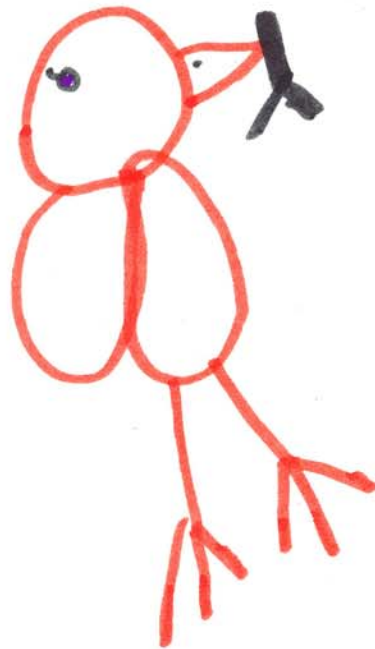
### **Independent Wood Working with Robert Sherman Grades 4-6**

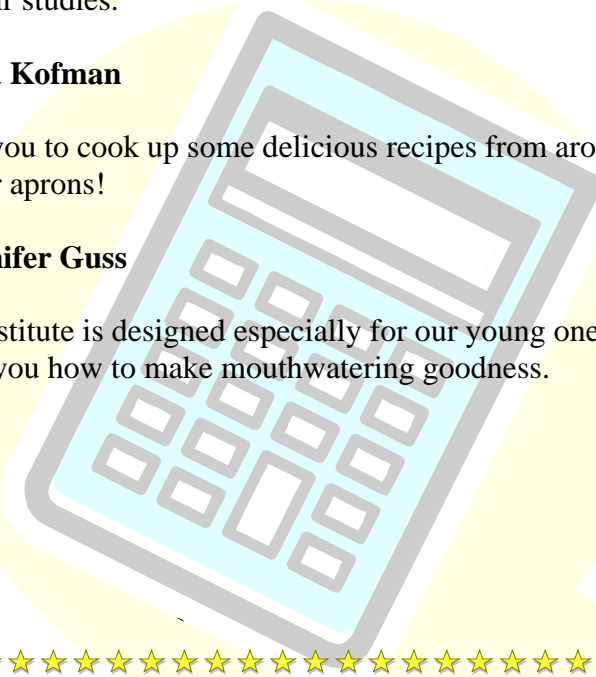
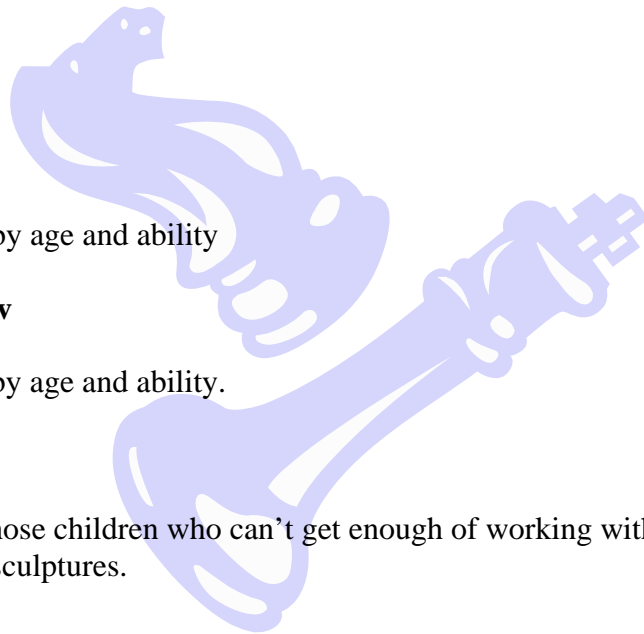

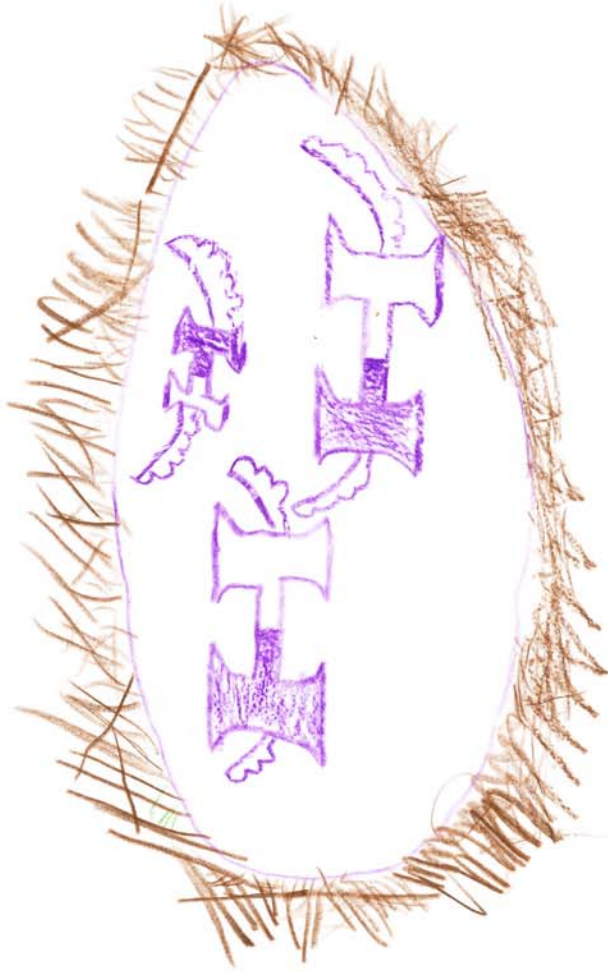
